1. On 9 June 59 an attempt was made to contact Mr. Robert Edward Webster by telephone by [redacted] who talked with his wife. He told her that he wanted to talk to Mr. Webster regarding "some business" but she stated, rudely, that he was out of the country. From her reaction it appeared that she did not want to talk about her husband.

2. The conversation lasted only two to three minutes. [redacted] did not identify himself as working for the US government nor did he leave his name or telephone number. Since 9 June 59 no other attempts have been made to contact Mr. Webster.
