No new info except "we have never remunerated him....".

His position as manager of International Trade Mart "...resulted in eight reports of which six were evaluated "of value" and two "of slight value". His contact in N.O. field office was Hunter C. Leake. Relationship was discontinued "as the shotgun approach to collection efforts waned and it became obvious that Shaw was becoming more and more interested in his private ventures and less and less in the activities of ~~the~~ International Trade Mart. He resigned as manager of International Trade Mart on 1 October 65."
