1. WE RECENTLY RECEIVED CORRESPONDENCE FROM THE LMPURE SECURITY OFFICER STATING INFORMATION FROM ANOTHER AGENCY INDICATES IDENTITY MAY BE OF INTEREST TO THE KGB. ACCORDING TO THIS INFORMATION A KGB OFFICER WHO HAD KNOWN IDENTITY DURING A PREVIOUS TOUR OF DUTY WAS TRANSFERRED TO TOKYO WHEN IDENTITY WAS ASSIGNED TO THAT POST. THE OTHER AGENCY BELIEVES THE KGB OFFICER VIKTOR DMITRIYEVICH KOLOSOV, AKA KOSCILOV, A SPECIALIST IN AMERICAN CODE CLERKS/ MAY HAVE GONE TO TOKYO SPECIFICALLY FOR SOME PURPOSE CONNECTED WITH AN AMERICAN IDENTITY.

2. THE LMPURE SECURITY OFFICER ASKED THAT WE REVIEW OUR FILES TO DETERMINE IF IDENTITY REPORTED ANY CONTACTS WITH SOVIET NATIONALS DURING HIS TOKYO TOUR /1954-1957/ AND ALSO ASCERTAIN WHETHER ANY MOLADY PERSONNEL HAVE REPORTED CONTACTS WITH KOLOSOV.

3. ABOVE FORWARDED FOR YOUR INFORMATION. REQUEST HEADQUARTERS TRACES ON IDENTITY AND KOLOSOV. STATION TRACES NEGATIVE.
