A CUBAN BUSINESSMAN IN EXILE WHO TRAVELS ABROAD FREQUENTLY AND HAS GOOD ACCESS TO CUBAN DIPLOMATIC INSTALLATIONS; FROM CARRILLO. SOURCE'S REPORTING HAS BEEN LIMITED.

- ANTONIO CARRILLO CARRERAS, CUBAN AMBASSADOR TO FRANCE, CONTINUES TO BE INTERESTED IN PURSUING POSSIBILITIES FOR IMPROVING CUBAN-U.S. RELATIONS. HE HAS REMARKED THAT ONE OF THE CONCESSIONS WHICH CUBA COULD CONSIDER INVOLVES THE GUARANTEED PURCHASE BY THE U.S. OF ONE MILLION TONS OF CUBAN SUGAR ANNUALLY. CUBA WOULD BE PREPARED TO APPLY APPROXIMATELY 20 PER CENT. OF THE PROCEEDS TO INDEMNIFY U.S. COMPANIES WHOSE PROPERTY HAS BEEN EXPROPRIATED BY THE CUBAN GOVERNMENT.
