SOURCE. Cuban businessman in exile who travels abroad frequently and has good access to Cuban diplomatic installations. His reporting has been limited.

In late September 1964 Antonio Carrillo Carreras, Cuban Ambassador to France, made the following comments about succession to Fidel Castro Ruz, and the personalities who are currently the most powerful political figures in Cuba:

- a. In the event of the disappearance of Fidel Castro from the scene, particularly through assassination, Raul Castro Ruz will take over immediately as leader in accordance with an established plan. Raul has the support of the army as well as that of other top Cuban leaders in Fidel's immediate group.
- b. In terms of authority, after Fidel and Raul, President
  Osvaldo Dorticós Torrado and Industries Minister Ernesto
  "Che" Guevara Serna follow in that order. Dorticos, who
  is widely respected in Cuba, now has specific responsibility
  for guiding the economy. Guevara, in spite of his foreign
  birth, has popular support and is generally considered a
  Cuban. Cuevara has not failed as Minister of Industries.
  The difficult functioning of the economy is attributable
  simply to the fact, that many key industries continue to
  use American equipment for which replacement parts cannot
  be acquired. Newer plants generally use Soviet and Czech
  equipment and they are now producing efficiently.
