Memo for the record 2 July 64

On 2 July at 10 A.M., Rodriguez was taken to the INS located at 119 D st.
N.E. room 547. He was attended by Mrs. Byard. Rodriguez filled the application
in true facts, was fingerprinted and sworn in. He was given the I-94 form
stating that he is in the US as a parolee.
