Going over the various debriefing reports on ANMUG-1, it would appear that the defector has an excellent memory and a faculty for being able to describe physical characteristics of many persons he has met but without being able to remember their names. Two cases in point are the Vella and the Tiberon. It occurs to us that possibly thought should be given to using the Identi-Kit as a means of getting a pictorial description of persons whose names the agent does not recall but whose descriptions are still with him.
