1. Acknowledgement is made of the WH/SA request, dated 1 May 1964, for Provisional Operational Approval to contact and assess AMAG/1, a former Cuban IS officer presently a defector in Washington, D.C.

2. According to the provisions of CSI-F No. 10-5, Paragraph 18 a, no Operational Approval or Provisional Operational Approval is required if the operation is for the purpose of bringing under control a target who is presumed to be heatile. This is a decision to be made by the operating division.

3. Should the Subject be <u>subsequently considered</u> for operational <u>use</u> in any capacity, it will be necessary to follow the <u>usual procedure</u> regarding the <u>approval</u> of agents for cperational use, as stated in CSI-F No. 10-5, Paragraph 18 b.
