

<p>1. At a 20 August 1968 meeting AMASHIP/2 was asked about a series of PERUVIANS (11 in all) who, he was told, are or have been in Rome. Included in the list at intervals were AMASH/1, 2, and 3. (DOWCE comment: In accordance with a discussion with LARROCH during his recent trip to Rome.) AMASHIP/2 was given no further information and nothing about the fifteen men except their names.</p> <p>a. Subject did not respond re AMASH/3.</p> <p>b. Subject had heard AMASHIP/1 and others mention AMASH/2, whom Subject does not know personally. He knew of him only that he had been in Paris a number of times and that he was said to be stupid.</p> <p>c. Subject knows AMASH/1 well, although not as well as does AMASHIP/2, through whom AMASHIP/2 met AMASH/1. Subject described AMASH/1 as a very complicated person of confusing and perhaps confused loyalties. Once, when AMASH/1 was so drunk and ill that he was leaning for the bathroom to vomit, he kept shouting curses at the AMTHUG regime which "murdered my son." Sober, he is also critical of AMTHUG. But as soon as anyone else is similarly critical, AMASH/1 immediately defends AMTHUG and his government. AMASHIP/2 believes that AMASH/1 is emotionally and psychologically mixed up and does not know where he stands.</p> <p>d. AMASHIP/2 knows why AMASHIP/1 and AMASH/1 met. (He did not state the reason and was not asked.) He knew, however, only through what AMASHIP/1 volunteered, and not through being present at any meetings. When these occurred, if AMASHIP/2 happened to be present, he left the room voluntarily and at the outset.</p>

2. Regarding Ambassador Antonio CARRILLO (Arrero) (201-34995a) AMSHIP/2 feels sure that he is not presently selectable and is clearly pro-regime. On the other hand, he is not happy in his job, complaining that he was not cut out to work constantly under pressure, and would prefer a quieter post in western Europe. With some help from Subject, arranging lodgings, CARRILLO has gone to Benidorm, Spain, for most or all of the month of August. (At least Subject thinks that he is there.) AMSHIP/2 was instructed to let us know whenever he is privy to the vacation plans of CARRILLO, or anyone else similarly placed, well enough in position and with the added proviso that he was not himself involved in the arrangements (Comment: So that, if a pitch seems reasonable, there will not be a danger of blow-back). As was reported earlier, it has been many months since CARRILLO has offered Subject any jewelry, and these transactions may have come to a close. CARRILLO did make a recent attempt to send a painting to AMSHIP/2.

3. Re Cuban pesos, AIRSHIP/7 has made repeated, discreet inquiries, alleging that he wants to send money to his wife's mother, who is dying of cancer. He states that it is impossible to get them. If it could be done, he says, [redacted] [redacted] (CIRAY-40385, 20 May 1965) could do it. And he can't. 06

22 4. AMHIP/2 continues to express grave concern about
AMHIP/1's sexual relationship with IBM A of GINA) 38996,
16 December 1984. Subject says that A/1 is now initiated that
he now wants a divorce in order to marry IBM. A/2 repeats
that IBM is a woman of loose morals who was notorious as such
even before she left Cuba. He stresses that A/1 tells her
everything: " alles, Alles, Alles!"

5. Finally, Subject said that information about A/1 which he had previously passed to BUNCE (secretly, he flatly refused to specify what information, although it is probable that it is the information about DIAK A) had been leaked back somehow to AMEMBASSY/1 several months ago. As a result, A/1 could have been put in a position to surmise that A/2 has a relationship with KUBARK, a fact which A/2 makes every effort to conceal from A/1 and everyone else, including A/2's wife. A/2 says that he has managed to divert any A/1 suspicions and smooth any ruffled feathers. However, because A/1 is his friend and business partner, and because A/2 is keenly aware of the importance of security, he asked that BUNCE guarantee that there will be no further leak, that BUNCE accept A/2 info in confidence, or that BUNCE recognize that A/2, lacking such guarantees, cannot furnish any more information which might get him into trouble. Headquarters comments are requested.
