Telephone Conversations with ANNIF/1 21 and 27 July 1965

- 1. On 21 July 1965 Al JHIP/1 called me (marry "lills") from Hew York to report he had returned from his Florida vacation. He had no news and was busy preparing a jevelry exhibit in New York. We agreed communicate again the following week.
- 2. On 27 July 1965 I called A/1 at his office. Again he had no further news.

 He confirmed he plans to go to Europe on business, leaving New York

 about late August and spending about six weeks abroad.
- 3. A/l expressed concern over visas for two relatives who applied for them at U.S. Embassy in Padrid following arrival from Cuba in April 1965.

 (He had expressed initial concern in April over them and two other relatives; in subsequent June meetings he indicated all was in order; now says two younger—couple have proper documentation, but not two older ladies.)

During 27 July conversation I told A/1 either I or I'r. Freitheim

would call him early week 2 August, to maintain contact.
