4. The records of this Agency reveal the following travel of Juan Guido LICEA Figueredo, identified as a Cuban diplomatic courier, taken from [redacted] His date of birth was given as 14 February 1929 in Habana. 24

- 15 September 1963 - Arrived Rio de Janeiro from Madrid
- 15 September 1963 - Left Rio de Janeiro for Santiago
- 11 October 1963 - Arrived Brussels from London
- 12 October 1963 - Left Brussels for Paris
- 14 October 1963 - Left Geneva for Rome
- 12 November 1963 - Left Habana for Mexico
- 14 November 1963 - Arrived Montevideo from Rio de Janeiro
- 15 November 1963 - Left Montevideo for Santiago
- 17 December 1963 - Left Rio de Janeiro for Montevideo
- 21 January 1964 - Arrived Brussels from Prague
- 22 March 1964 - Left Santiago for Montevideo
- 23 March 1964 - Left Montevideo for Rio de Janeiro

5. In a report dated 16 July 1964, it was stated that Juan GUIDO Licea, a Cuban diplomatic courier, had applied for a Canadian non-immigrant visa in order to visit the Cuban Embassy in Ottawa for a period of one week. The following information on GUIDO was taken from the visa application:

GUIDO was born on 14 February 1929 in Habana, Cuba, and is a Cuban citizen. He is a diplomatic courier for the Ministry of Foreign Relations and his purpose of entry into Canada was listed as diplomatic courier. He holds Cuban diplomatic passport D/64/250 issued on 10 April 1964 at Habana. His permanent address is Calzada y G, Vedado, Habana, Cuba.

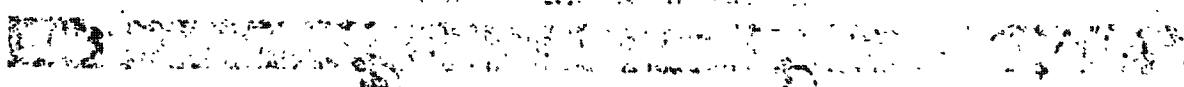
