Headquarters Comments

The following report is one of a series containing personality information provided by the source and includes supplemental information from the records of this Agency.

It is requested that the addressees take no action on any of the individuals mentioned in the personality reports without first checking with this Agency.

Source identified Mario OIZ Folgueiro as a Cuban diplomatic courier. OIZ was on the same flight as source when source traveled from Havana to Mexico in March 1964. 1, 2, 3

Headquarters Comments

1. In a report dated 9 July 1963, a usually reliable source revealed that Mario OIZ Figueroa arrived in Santiago, Chile, from Mexico on 8 July 1963. He carried Cuban passport number D/63/447 and was identified as a diplomatic courier. His date and place of birth were given as 2 January 1940 in Habana.
2. A report dated 17 July 1963, from a usually reliable source revealed that Mario OIZ Folgueira, a Cuban who was born on 2 January 1939 and carrying Cuban passport number D/63/477, was a diplomatic courier who arrived in Santiago, Chile, on
