Headquarters Comments

The following report is one of a series containing personality information provided by the source and includes supplemental information from the records of this Agency.

It is requested that the addressees take no action on any of the individuals mentioned in the personality reports without first checking with this Agency.

- Guillermo JIMENEZ, pseudonym "Javier," is chief of the Department of Information Services (SI) of the Dirección General de Inteligencia (General Directorate of Intelligence - DGI) and considered one of the three top people in the DGI. He resides at Calle este entre 35 y 37 Nuevo Vedado, Habana.
- JIMENEZ traveled to Moscow with Manuel PINERO sometime after March 1964. JIMENEZ was also involved in the trial of Marcos RODRIGUEZ who was executed in Cuba on 17 April 1964.^{1,2,3}

Headquarters Comments

- The following information on Guillermo JIMENEZ is information received after the dissemination of the above referenced report.
- An untested source, in a report dated 24 January 1964, said that he first met Guillermo JIMENEZ in the Castillo del Príncipe Prison in September 1961, where source was being held after a routine arrest in the Hotel Capri in August 1961. JIMENEZ, allegedly, was the first person to attempt to recruit source on behalf of the G-2. JIMENEZ

was a Comandante in the Rebel Army and in mid-1962 was serving in the Ministry of Foreign Relations. Source said JIMENEZ was a good friend of Faure CHOMON. Source described JIMENEZ as intelligent, well indoctrinated politically, and that he had attended the University of Havana. Source also said that he had heard that JIMENEZ had visited the Soviet Union three times in 1959 and 1960. He was born about 1931, is five feet six inches tall, 135 pounds, has black, short, curly hair, black eyes, a dark complexion and a medium build.

3. This same source, in a report dated 28 January 1964, said that Guillermo JIMENEZ is a Cuban citizen residing at Castillo de Principe, Cuba, and a Cuban Intelligence Service officer.
