"Rafael" is the nephew of Guillermo ARASTAGUIA (Subject of CSCI-316/00643-64 of 11 August 1964).¹

1. The above Subject is not identical with the Subject of CSCI-316/00430-65 of 2 February 1965. The records of this Agency reveal no identifiable information on "Rafael."
