The following report is one of a series containing personality information provided by the source and includes supplemental information from the records of this Agency.

It is requested that the addressees take no action on any of the individuals mentioned in the personality reports without first checking with this Agency.

In 1955, when source first met Julio Damaso VASQUEZ, VASQUEZ was working for a nickel enterprise. In 1959 he partic**ppated** in the Cuban invasion of Panama and remained in Panama in hiding in the mountains for about a month after the failure of the invasion. Eventually VASQUEZ was caught and put in jail, remaining there for about four months. Source met him again when source reported for duty with the Direccion General de Inteligencia (General Directorate of Intelligence -DGI).<sup>1</sup>

## Headquarters Comment

1. Although Subject's patronymic was first given as DAMASO, source has since verified that VASQUEZ is the correct patronymic. Aside from the information forwarded in the above referenced report, this Agency has no additional pertinent information.
