Fnu PENA, alias "Lorenzo," in 1962, was head of the MA (Intelligence) Department of the Direction General de Inteligencia (General Directorate of Intelligence - DGI) which was later divided into three separate departments: Centros Legales (Legal Centers - MS); Ilegal (Illegal); and Liberacion Nacional (National Liberation - LN). He was later a trainee in the LN, Guatemalan Bureau. In early 1963 he was sent to Mexico for several months. Upon his return he spent some time at the DGI Headquarters, not in an operational section, and was later transferred to the Ministry of Interior.1
