Headquarters Comments . The following report is one of a series containing personality information provided by the source and includes supplemental information from the records of this Agency.

It is requested that the addressees take no action on any of the individuals mentioned in the personality reports without first checking with this Agency.

Source was re-queried concerning additional information on Manuel VEGA Perez, the Subject of the above referenced report, and gave the following information:

His full name is Manuel Eugenio VEGA Perez, pseudonym "Marcos," and he was born about 1919. He is five feet five inches in height, has a heavy build, a white complexion, curly hair, and a round, clean shaven face.

VEGA is a Diplomatic Attache at the Cuban Embassy in Mexico City and the chief of intelligence there. He arrived in Cuba from Mexico in November 1963 and was assigned to the
