Headquarters Comments:

The following report is one of a series containing personality information provided by the source and includes supplemental information from the records of this Agency.

It is requested that the addressees take no action on any of the individuals mentioned in the personality reports without first checking with this Agency.

1. Miguel ROA is an officer in the Direccion General de Inteligencia (DGI - General Directorate of Intelligence) and has been stationed in Mexico for probably more than one year. In Mexico, for cover purposes, he holds the position of Press Attache, this comes under the Ministry of Foreign Relations. He has visited Habana and when there, visits the office building where the Liberacion Nacional (LN - National Liberation) section of the DGI is located. He has also visited Reneal PINERO at his office apartment.
2. Prior to being assigned to the DGI and to the Ministry of Foreign Relations, ROA was a first lieutenant in the National Police in 1959 to 1960.
