SUBJECT: General: AMMUG/1 Debrieflag Report #146

Specific: Ramon *PASTOF Llorens

PDOB: 10 August 1912, Spain

Clt: Canadian

1. On 3 February 1965, AMMUG/1 was briefled further on Ramon FASTOR Llorens, the bartender at Halifax International Airport in Canada.

- 2. According to AMMUG/1, PASTOR assisted him when he decided to defect while en route to Czechoslovakia. AMMUG/1 had no prior anowledge of PASTOR or any activities on his part in assisting Cubans to defect at Hallfax. When AMMUG/1 debarked the plane during refueling at Hallfax, he went into the restaurant along with the other passengers on the flight. Upon entering the restaurant, AMMUG/1 observed PASTOR speaking Spanish and assisting passengers to obtain what they needed. He then approached PASTOR and requested that PASTOR take him to the Canadian immigration authorities as he wished to remain in Canada. PASTOR did this and assisted in interpreting AMMUG/1's desires to the Canadians.
- 5. Eased on the above, it is very possible that the Cuban Government is not aware of PASTOR's activities, if he has been at all active, in assisting Cuban defectors.
