1. Following are a few additional items of information from the photo logs concerning the persons who were identified by A33UG-1 as entering the Cuban Embassy.

- a. Film 294 photo 1 Mexican lawyer who does errands for
- Film 293 photo 23 members of the Cuban Embassy
- Film 300 photo 30

This person entered the Cuban Embassy in a Cadillac car with license plates 7-14-73 which in 1963 were registered to Aurelio MUÑOZ Seileiro, Martires de Tacubaya No. 39. Station files contain a reference to one Aurelio MUÑOZ who is contributor to the PCR.

- b. Film 278 photos 19 & 20 Diplomatic couriers

The subject of phot. 20 is a courier named Augustin YACCELLS Gonzalez who transits Mexico about every other month.

- c. Film 279 photo 9 Jorge IAIN

Jorge IAIN departed Mexico PCS on 18 May 1964. [redacted] indicated his departure may have been sudden and unexpected.

- d. Film 256 photo 8 Felipe LIAUDI

LIAUDI was seen entering the Cuban Embassy in the company of Rogelio RODRIGUEZ Lopez on this date.

- e. Film 183 photo 1 Carlos BELGIA
Film 151 photo 27

Carlos BELGIA was observed leaving the Cuban Embassy on 26 June 1963 at 0920 which possibly implies that he was staying at the Embassy. A check of the Cuban travel run for 1963 shows no record of BELGIA's travel to Mexico.

- f. Film 264 photo 24 Alfonso PEREZ Leon - Cuban courier

Alfonso PEREZ Leon transits Mexico about every other month. He usually goes to Santiago, Chile, but in August made a trip to Tokyo.
