ACTION REQUIRED - REFERENCES

- Attached is a letter from KUVOLF Staff to <sup>02</sup>CEIVORY, suggesting that two <sup>02</sup>CEIVORY assets contact AMBUD-1 to request a list of suitable teaching candidates for a KUVOLF/<sup>02</sup>CEIVORY sponsored project <sup>02</sup>DEBEEF.
- Should such contact in fact take place, AMBUD-1 may ask your advice as to a reply. We hope that you would pretend to check out the persons and project involved, and then suggest to AMBUD-1 that he cooperate in answering the request. You could emphasize that the project is a strong and well regarded effort to fight Communism in Latin America.

Pursuant to our discussion with you in New York on 18 January, we have talked with our colleagues about the possibility of arranging for qualified Cuban and Christian Democrats to teach in the project ORDEEF. They suggest that the best way to proceed would be for IDEN A or IDEN B to contact Miro Cardona, head of the Cuban Revolutionary Council, in Miami and request him to recommend IDEN candidates. It was explained that:

- (1) Since the Cuban CD movement is a part of Cardona's Cuban Revolutionary Council, Cardona himself will have to approve the participation of Cuban Christian Democrats in the project ORDEEF.
- (2) Cardona, better than anyone else, can tell us who among Christian Democrats would be best for the job in terms of ability as a speaker and teacher and who at the same time would be spared (by Cardona) from the CRC for this purpose. Cardona's address is:

If you decide against contacting Cardona, we might be able to supply some names to add to those whom IDEN A or IDEN B do not already have access to independently.
