- The VENUS, a 110-foot boat which is used as a mother ship by the Junta Revolucionaria Cubana (JURE, Cubana Revolutionary Junta), and two Boston Whalers, were in the American sector of Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic, on 20 July 1965. The government of Antonio Imbert Barrera had confiscated the weapons which were aboard, Including personal as well as boat-mounted weapons. Hanuel Ray Rivero, leader of JURE, said that regardless of who won the struggle for power in the Dominican Republic, the weapons would be returned to JURE because JURE was on good terms with both sides of the conflict.

Field Comment: TDCSDB-315/00539-65 dated 16 February 1965, from the same source, reported Rabel's plan to commandeer the VENUS and the two whalers. It was believed that he planned to use the VENUS to exfiltrate his wife from Cuba, or to stage a commando raid against a Cuban target.
