SUBJECT: Lee Harvey OSWALD

1. Subsequent to the preparation of our CSCL-3/777,617, dated 4 February 1964, subject as above, in response to your communication DL 100-10461, dated 31 December 1963, file number (S) 105-82555, additional information on the subject has come to our attention. This information was received from your office in your communication DBA 59901, dated 20 December 1963. It is repeated below for the convenience of your personnel involved in the OSWALD case.

2. Concerning the entry on page 03 of OSWALD's address book:

Lev Setyaev - Radio Moscow  
Leo Setyaev  
V3-05-80 (work)  
Novo-Zreschanaya 23/7  
Apt. 65'

a report from your office, DBA 59901, dated 20 December 1963, subject Lillie May RAHM, contains the following information: Annette (nee ZUGOFF) SETYAEVA, aka Anita May ZUGOFF, aka Aneta May ZUGOFF, aka Annette K. HENKINA, born 18 November 1919 at Lake Stevens, Washington is married to a Leo SETYAEV who worked for Radio Moscow; Annette SETYAEVA, who appears to be the daughter of Lillie May RAHM, aka Lillie May TESLICH, aka Lillie May ZUGOFF, born 8 November 1902 at Wells Township, Michigan, travelled to the Soviet Union in 1935 and on 20 March 1936 became a citizen of the USSR. At least until July 1962, Annette was reportedly married to a HENKIN, (fnu). For a number of years Annette has worked as an announcer in the American Section of Radio Moscow. Allegedly, she is the Radio Moscow announcer known as

/"Moscow Molly" who

'Moscow Molly' who broadcasts an English language program, reportedly containing, surprisingly factual and intimate details of life at US bases in the Alaskan Command, ostensibly calculated to destroy troop morale at these bases.

2. Annette K. SETYAEVA presumably together with Leo (Lev) SETYAEV) was reported to be residing at Hotel'nicheskaya 1/15, Section V, Apt. 79, Moscow, USSR.

3. The 1960 Moscow Telephone Directory lists a R. V. PHENKIN, telephone: B-74759 at the address Hotel'nicheskaya 1/15. No apartment number is listed. There are no further traces on SETYAEV or PHENKIN (PHENKIN). Except for reports of your office, there are also no further traces on KAHM or SETYAEVA.

4. Your office will be advised of any further pertinent information.
