**1. Transmitted herewith are two reports dealing with Danialars
KUCI-KOSKI and one report on Chester KLEBOSKI.**

**2. Headquarters' files contain no additional information on
KUCI-KOSKI.**

**3. The attached reports present the highlights of KUCI-KOSKI's
activities which are pertinent to our current interests; however, the
following item of information lends credence to the supposition that
KUCI-KOSKI has had connections with the US: A report dated 4 August
1957 from [redacted] states that KUCI-KOSKI, then
Charge d'Affaires at the Polish Legation in Teheran, was known to have
made a "recruitment" approach while on a trip to Kabul, Afghanistan, in
mid-1957.**
