- Forwarded herewith is a print of a photo of Subject. The print is not the best due to the poor quality of the original. It is obviously of a much younger man and we believe is probably dated about 1947.
- Subject was the exposed in an article appearing in the "The Reporter" magazine, issue of March 1953, as attempting to recruit an American professor, Daniel AARON, who applied for a visa to the USSR at the Soviet Embassy, Helsinki. If subject is identical with Fedor Alekseyevich SHCHERBAKOV of reference A., the magazine publicity might explain why he is using another name when visiting Finland.
- During Subject's tour of duty in Cuba and the United States, 1945 to 1950, he was in contact with such notorious American Communists as SILVERMASTER and individuals involved in the Judith COPIAN case. The "Reporter" story provides a fairly good description of subject's physical appearance and personality and we are attaching a copy of the article in case one is not on file in .
