

SOURCE: A Cuban exile who was prominent in politics at the provincial level in Cuba, source is well known by the Cuban exiles and has reported objectively on their political maneuvers. Source occasionally receives information directly from Cuba. Source's reporting has lacked depth. This information was obtained from Miryan Talled.

- On 14 January 1965 ^{SAFE} Miryan ^{SAFE} Talled, a member of the women's section of the Segundo Frente Nacional del Escambray (SFNE, Second National Front of the Escambray) who carries out secretarial duties for Tania Salas, wife of Eloy Gutierrez Menoyo, military leader of the SFNE, said that more than 100 men had entered Cuba with Gutierrez. Among those who infiltrated were Captain Enrique "Kiko" Pernas, Captain Angel Banos Pantoja, and Pedro Paez, brother of Commandant Cesar Paez Sanchez. Paez has many friends in Flacetas, Las Villas Province, his birthplace.
- Miryan also said that Gutierrez has good contacts in Pinar del Rio and Oriente Provinces. However, Gutierrez and "Lucas," her boy friend who is said to be second in command of the infiltration group, plan to operate in the Escambray Mountains of Las Villas.
- When Miryan expressed her deep concern for his well being, "Lucas" reassured her that Gutierrez and his men were well aware of Cuba's armed might, but that they had faith in their contacts and in the manner in which they were to fight against Castro.
