An educated Cuban exile who is active in several exile political organizations. He maintains correspondence with several residents in Cuba. He is a fairly reliable reporter on the internal politics of the refugee groups. This information was obtained from discussions with Major Aurelio Nazario 201-269349 Sargen and Dr. Diego Medina Rodriguez, officials of the SFNK.

- As of 9 November 1964, Eloy Gutierrez Menoyo, military leader of the Segundo Frente Nacional del Escambray (SFNE, Second Mational Front of the Escambray), member organization of the Alliance formed by the SFNE, Alpha 66, and the Hovimiento Revolucionario del Pueblo (MRP, Revolutionary Movement of the People), had been joined by almost all his men who had undergone military training. As a result, Gutierrez ordered the establishment, preferably in the Miami area, of a small camp for training additional men. The camp is to be a small one, just large enough to accommodate 12 to 14 men, because Gutierrez does not want to become legally entangled with American authorities and can not afford any large expenditures.
- Gutierrez temporarily halted his activities before the American presidential elections allegedly under instructions from unidentified persons. However, he plans to resume them once again, directing them against the destruction of the forthcoming Cuban sugar/crop.

ch wich Dr. Armando Rleitas Diaz, who has established a headquarters in Caracas, Venezuela, in order to raise money for the SFNE, recently sent more than \$6,000 to the Miami office.

Major/Andres Nazario Sargen has set up a base of operations in New York and plans to visit the 16 delegations the Alliance has organized in the northern United States, including Chicago, and Boston. Nazario hopes to increase the enthusiasm of the Alliance's followers in that area, which seemed to have waned screwhat during recent months as a result of lack of activity against Cuba.
