Inacouch as Subject s 201 file was cont to Readquarters in July 1961 the Station does not have a complete. record of Subject's background and relationship, if say, with the Soviets.
- 2. The most recent information in the Station's files on Subject, who has been series in Communist labor vaices since 1945, is that be attended the Soviet Amiversary colebrations hold in a theater is Bogota in early Revember 1954 after which he went to Revens, via Maxico, on 27 Hovember 1964 on opecial invitation of Fidel Costro.
