1. On Tuesday morning, 14 Hovember 1/61, I contacted Mr.  EE Bivision, who is still the senior case officer for the MEVISION Case, and inquired of him whether the source had ever been questioned on his possible knowledge of the FIELS Case. Mr. advised that he did not believe that any such queries had been put to MEVISION, but added that the same thought had crossed his own mind only a short time ago. Mr. indicated that the volume of requirements which had had to be worked into the schedule of source debriefings was so great, that this was but one of a whole series of cases and personalities which should be covered with MEVISION as the time allows. In view of the fact that Mr. was planning to see MEVISION that afternoon, he suggested that it might be advisable for him to discuss the matter with the source immediately, and attempt to ferret out whether MEVISION could provide any information at all concerning the FREINS, their Bisappearance, the involvement of their respective relatives, including the BOOBS, et al.	
2. This afternoon, Mr. advised by telephone that he actually had questioned ETVISION on his knowledge of the FIELDS, et al, and had determined that the source actually had no knowledge of the case save what source had acquired from the press. He indicated that although the case of Hermann Field had been discussed in Foland, he, the source, had gained the impression that the facts of the case were pretty tach as revealed at the time of Hermann FIELD's release from custody in 1954 (?), and that he had never heard any indications from source's Soviet Intelligence Contacts to indicate that any of the FIELDs had been involved in intelligence operations for the Soviets.
