1. On 16 January 1963, the undersigned discussed the PECHON use of *BERNARD/2* as noted in the above reference, with Harry H. LAMOND from the Munich Base transmitting Paris.

2. The Station pointed out that it has no objections to the use of *BERNARD/2* as outlined in the above reference. LAMOND was briefed, however, of the inherent security danger in view of the fact that the local [redacted] [redacted] have attempted to approach *BERNARD/2* for possible *BERNARD* activities. Arrangements for continuing safe contact with *BERNARD/2* from Munich has been arranged and given to LAMOND.
