ADMINISTRATIVE

Relative to the interviews of Mr. and Mrs. RICHARD V. LE CLAIR set out in details of report, a lead was set out for Dallas in Milwaukee tel to Bureau and Dallas dated 12/3/63 to identify the funeral home employee and investigate circumstances.

Relative to the interview of MARGARET BUDREAU as set out in details of this report, Dallas and the Bureau were advised by teletype dated 12/4/63 and Dallas was given additional detailed information by airtel the same date and was requested to consider the information in the light of facts known concerning subject's whereabouts in July, 1963.

Concerning the interviews of NORMAN FREDERIKSEN and his wife. ELKE FREDERIKSEN as requested by reference Dallas teletype to Milwaukee 12/3/63, the results of which are set out in FD-302's in this report, it may be noted that NORMAN FREDERIKSEN said that he couldn't recall VOLKMAR SCHMIDT as being present at the EVERETT GLOVER party in February, 1963 at which OSWALD spoke. NORMAN FREDERIKSEN also stated that he became suspicious of OSWALD principally because he managed to get his Russianborn wife out of Russia and he also recalls that a friend of his said that OSWALD, upon his return from Russia to the United States, wouldn't take a job unless it was in a photographic lab. When asked the source of this he said he felt this friend might possibly have been ILYA MAMANDOR, an employee of the Socony Company of Dallas, who apparently is Russian born but now a citizen of the United States. He further stated that ILYA MAMANDOR wouldn't have come to the GLOVER party. if he had been invited because ILYA wouldn't go to any place
