"Source advised that several weeks ago he talked with a fellow prisoner, VERNON BUNDY. VERNON BUNDY, an Orleans Parish prisoner, testified in District Attorney JAMES GARRISON'S KENNEDY assassination probe that he, BUNDY, saw CLAY L. SHAW pass money to someone on the New Orleans lakefront. BUNDY indicated to source he had been offered a deal by District Attorney GARRISON if he would testify to a story about SHAW. According to source, this conversation allegedly took place several weeks ago in New Orleans Parish Prison prior to the time BUNDY testified at the hearing in Criminal District Court. At the time of the conversation, BUNDY was undecided what course of action to take but told source he, BUNDY, would do anything to get out of his sentence. BUNDY indicated indirectly, his testimony was not true without stating directly so, or that a story had been given to him to tell."
