Mobile, Alabama. Informant advised that subjects may be involved in narcotics traffic. Informant contact in Mobile negative regarding alleged activity. Subjects BURKE were nephews of a well-known and influential New Orleans politician. Case was administratively closed February 24, 1958, inasmuch as investigation had failed to identify any of the subjects' alleged victims, and since it had failed to substantiate the remarks of the complainant.

On October 9, 1959, NO 1075-C advised that HENRY SOTO was involved in working as a pimp in the New Orleans French Quarter.

On June 9, 1965, ELIZABETH I. MC CANN, was., PCI, advised that HENRY SOTO was one of several individuals involved in prostitution activity in New Orleans.

On November 25, 1966, NO 1439 advised that HENRY SOTO was possibly subject involved in theft of \$4,000 worth of jewelry and other valuables stolen from home of a New Orleans resident.

In airtel to Bureau, dated November 13, 1958, entitled, "CRIMDEL - CRS," New Orleans file number 94-336, information received from New Orleans Police Department related that HENRY LAWRENCE SOTO had allegedly beaten a woman at a bar in the New Orleans French Quarter. Police informants identify SOTO as a narcotics pusher in the New Orleans area.

New Orleans file 91-3032, entitled, "BANK BURGLARY SUSPECTS" carries HENRY L. SOTO as an individual to be questioned in a bank robbery case. Serial 27 carries SOTO's name with listed FBI number 586-073-B, New Orleans Police Department number 62809, and Identification Record citing SOTO on numerous cases involving narcotics, aggravated assault, simple armed robbery, and possession of burglary tools. His record indicates violations in the following states: Louisiana, California, Kansas, Pennsylvania, Tennessee, Illinois, and Missouri.
