It is pointed out that CATHERINE BLAIME BOND was not interviewed, as her present whereabouts is unknown. However, the facts developed thus far reflect that there is no apparent basis for the allegations in Mrs. TRACY's letter, and when interviewed, Mrs. TRACY attributed all derogatory and violent remarks made concerning former President KENNEDY to CHARLOTTE REGAN and, therefore, no additional investigation is being conducted to locate and interview CATHERINE BLAINE BOND, UACB.

The source who requested her identity not be divulged and who furnished information regarding CHARLOTTE RAWDALL MC ELFRESH, reflected in the attached enclosures, is LA 3436-S, Bufile 100-374664. It should be noted that LA 3436-S is the daughter of CHARLOTTE RANDALL MC ELFRESH.
