ASSASSINATION of President John F. KENNEDY  
On 8/7/67, CSNY (4677-S) furnished the following information, which was obtained from a non-controlled source, whose reliability is not known:

A Cuban, believed to be of Mexican origin, known only as "SPONTEJO", and described as a "G-2 agent", was reportedly involved in the assassination of President JOHN F. KENNEDY.

The source is unable to furnish any additional clarifying information, and, in order to better evaluate the source of the foregoing information, has requested any information identifiable with "SPONTEJO".

Indices of the NYO were carefully searched, concerning captioned, including phoenetic variations thereof, with negative results.

The Bureau is requested to search indices for any pertinent identifiable information which may be furnished to the source.
