Enclosed for the Bureau are five copies of a letterhead memorandum (LHM) dealing with a recent meeting between CG [6666-S] and this Yugoslav principal, FILIP CURCIC. Copies are sent to offices with Yugoslav diplomatic establishments within their territory, and to offices involved in the DIPBOM case. (S)

On 2/21/67, CG [6666-S] was contacted regarding a meeting held with FILIP CURCIC, Consul, Yugoslav Consulate, Chicago, Illinois. This meeting was held on 2/17/67. Informant also saw CURCIC on 2/20/67, as will be explained later. (S)

Upon contacting CURCIC, informant noted that CURCIC was extremely anxious to see him and informant went to CURCIC's apartment at 5:00 p.m., Saturday, 2/17/67. CURCIC was not at home, however, he arrived within a few minutes. Informant noted that he was extremely nervous and seemed pale which was totally in contrast to prior meetings. The U. S. "will" be declared unsafe for diplomacy. The Yugoslavs would not be satisfied without prosecution. They will insist that the U. S. conduct investigations and determine who perpetrated the bombings and punish them. He reiterated that the Yugoslavs would not accept the case unsolved. They know who did it and the U. S. knows who did it. He was firm in his conclusion that someone must go to jail. He indicated this was the official thinking of the Yugoslav government in Belgrade, Yugoslavia. (S)(u)

This has not been reduced to paper until this time inasmuch as it is the custom with this informant to allow him to attempt to ascertain further information from the meeting, should he have forgotten any points. He has been recontacted since the 2/21/67, contact and has advised that there were no further salient points. (S)(u)

The source utilized in the LHM is CG [6666]^(S)-S and the LHM is classified "Secret" in order to protect the identity of the informant, who is involved in a double agent operation. (S)(u) The reliability memorandum is not classified inasmuch as no indication is included pertaining to the interest of the FBI in a Yugoslav diplomatic establishment. (S)
