On 3/2/64 SA 648-S furnished the writer an oral report which was subsequently transcribed and thereafter acknowledged by informant on 3/3/64. This report is filed in 134-363A-184, and reads as follows:

On Wednesday, February 26, 1964, TED CASTILLO and JOHN STANFORD were seen picking up RENE SANDOVAL at the S-N-S Ice House on San Pedro, in CASTILLO's car.

Thereafter while TED CASTILLO drove his car to the southwest side of San Antonio a Communist Party meeting was held.

TED CASTILLO spoke of PASO and its 1964 convention. CASTILLO claimed that the meeting was very satisfactory for the liberal movement.
