Reference is made to our memoranda dated April 6, 1959, and July 9, 1959, concerning the subject. Reference is also made to Telegram Number 746 from the United States Embassy, Havana, Cuba, to the Secretary of State dated August 15, 1960. The telegram indicated that Cubela, President of the Cuban Federation of University Students, had departed Havana for Geneva, Switzerland, on August 14, 1960. The telegram also indicated that Jose Venegas would accompany Cubela and that both are anti-American extremists who could be expected to criticize the United States during their trip.

Enclosed is a copy of a memorandum dated August 29, 1960, at New York City entitled Embassy of Cuba, Washington, D. C., (S) Internal Security - Cuba, which indicates Cubela was in New York City on August 14, 1960, and plans to contact Jose Vasquez Blanco, Consular Attache at the Cuban Consulate, New York City, at a later date while in the United States en route back to Cuba from Switzerland. Prior data has been furnished your Department indicating Vasquez Blanco conducts intelligence activities on behalf of the Cuban Government (S)

In view of Cubela's background, we are interested in knowing if he was in the United States legally and if his re-entry into the United States upon the completion of his visit to Switzerland will be permitted. 105-77667-7
