Instant investigation was instituted as a result of the receipt of information from Mi T-1, another Government agency which conducts intelligence and personnel investigations. 104 T-1 said that on August 4, 1959. a fairly reliable source in Cuba reported that RICARDO MADAH was one of those who was an agent of the Cuban Covernment operating in and out of Mania Florida.

Ca May 13, 1954, the New York Office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation advised that Assistant United States Attorney RIGIARD CHEM, Southern District of New York, adviced that he intended to start presenting evidence to the Federal Grand Jury on May 13, 1954, seeking a superceding indictment against certain individuals for compairacy to violate Section 452D, Title 22, United States Code. One of those named was RICARDO MADAN. CHEN said MADAN, who had not previously appeared in the investigation conducted in the matter, was a freight forwarder and an alleged arus eauggler.

On January 25, 1955, JAMES OFFUTT, Assistant Supervising Customs Agent in Miami, advised that investigation by United States Customs relative to the Federal laws involving exporting of arms and ammunition without a license or conspiracy to do so as prescribed in Section 452D, Title 22 and Section 371 of Title 18, United States Code, resulted in the conviction of RICARDO MADAN in the Federal Court in Naw York City upon MADAN's plea of nolle contenders. MADAN was fined \$2,500.00.

On September 24, 1956, MM T-2, Chan a Cubin Government of flosial, advised that a membership list of the Patriotic Club of July 25 in Mismi, which had been furnished to informant by a confidential source which ha believed to be reliable, listed the name of RAFAEL MADAN RIVAS, with no address given. Informant was unable to furnish any additional information concerning this macter.

On November 23, 1956, MM T-2 and 19 T-3, also as the the the the the Gran Government, both advised what they had received information from a very reliable informant who was a close associate of former Cuban President CANLOS-PRIO, that an emissary of PRIO had just returned from the Dominican Republic where their informant was in close contact with the PRIO group in the Dominican Republic. Their informant reported as follows: PRIO was being used as a front by Generalissimo RAFAES-TRUJILLO, head of the Dominican Republic, in a plan to launch a revolutionary accase against the BATISTA Government of Cuba. TRUJILLO was being aided by small factions of Cubans led by POLICARPO-SOLER, a Cuban gangster who fled Cuba following the overthrow of PRIO in 1952. POLICARPO went to the Dominican Republic

Reportedly POLICARPO began conspiring with TRUJILLO and was subsequently joined in the Dominican Republic by CANDIDO DE LA-TORRE, former PRIO associate, RICARDO MADAN, also a former PRIO associate who had been involved in gun smuggling activities in the Mizmi area during the recent past, EUFEMIO-FERNANDEZ, former Chief of Police and PRIO associate and by JESUS-GONZALEZ, known as "THE STRANGER", who went to the Dominican Republic several months ago after fleeing Cuba in a small fishing boat.

PRIO sent an emissary who reported that the group of Cubans led by POLICARPO obeyed TRUJILLO and TRUJILLO considered them "his own men".



MM T-4 said that on December 27, 1956, it was reported that SANCHEZ was working with RICARDO MADAN, and they were responsible for shipping a large quantity of arms into Cuba by use of the Air Express Service.

MM T-4 said that on April 27, 1957, a report was received that SANGEEZ and MADAN had been sentenced to death by certain elements of the "PRIO cause", who accused them of not having distributed all of the amountain for the attack on the Fresidential Palace in Havana on March 13, 1957. MM T-4 said that this report of April 27, 1957, indicated that SANGEEZ had accused MADAN of being the only one responsible for the failure of the attack on the Palace.



On April 6, 1959, MM T-6 advised that RICARDO MADAN, who lives on Lanapa Street in Miami Springs, Florida, has an office at the Eagle Shipping Company, 3212 Northwest North River Drive, Miami, reportedly was appointed as an investigator by SERGIO SANJENIS, the then Head of the Cuban investigative agency known as DIER (Department of Investigations of the Revolutionary Army). MM T-6 said that others who were appointed were ALBERTO LOPEZ LOPEZ, TONY FARINAS, JOE PAULA, and CARLOS MARTINEZ.

MM T-2 advised that he knows MADAN personally 2 and does not like him, but believes that during the period of the mid-1950's MADAN was working for money.

MM T-2 stated that he would describe MADAN as an exporter of arms and textiles in 1957.

MM T-2 said that in 1957 the largest cache of dynamite saized during that general period by the Cuban Covernment was reportedly MADAN's own, at least he was held to be responsible for its being in Cuba.

MM T-2 stated that MADAN now gets marble from Cuba and Maxico, and that MM T-2 has heard that MADAN has purchased machinery for making termized flooring from Italy, and that he still-owes money for such machinery.

On Fabruary 18, 1960, the files of the Immigration and Maturalization Service reflect that MADAN's number is A10-178-023. Their records reflect that his passport number was 03987, issued by the Republic of Cuba on March 12, 1953, and that it had an expiration date of March 11, 1958. His date and place of birth were listed as Havana, Cuba, December 25, 1912, and his address, at that time, was 4th Avenue between 48th and 50th Streets, Miramar, Havana, and his United States address was 1225 Southwest 22nd Terrace. His places of residence were listed as from birth to 1953, Havana, Cuba, and from -1953 to 1955, the time of the filing of the application for temporary stay in the United States, as in Miami most of the time. Reports from the Ministry of Justice of the Republic of Cube and from the musicipal jail in Bevane, both dated December 29, 1954, reflect that there was no record which would reflect on the character or the morality of MADAN as of those dates . A check of the Miami Police Department record of January 11, 1955, showed no record of MADAN, according to information contained in the above mentioned Immigration and Naturalization Service file.
