B. 1445 HOURS. YUGOSLAV AMB GUSTAV VLAHOV ASKS FOR SOVAMB BAZAROV. V TOLD THAT B AT DINNER. V SAYS WISHES SPEAK TO HIM REGARDLESS. B ANSWERS. V ASKS IF HE GOT ANY ADDITIONAL NEWS. B SAYS NO. V ASKS AND WHAT NATIONALITY, NOTHING IS KNOWN. B SAYS NO. V SAYS BECAUSE (MUFFLED WORD) HERE, THAT THE NATIONALITY IS LATIN AMERICAN. DO YOU UNDERSTAND? B SAYS YES, I THINK SO ALSO. IT IS VERY IMPORTANT. V SAYS THEN YOU KNOW NOTHING MORE? B SAYS NOTHING EXCEPT WHAT WAS BROADCAST ON RADIO.
