11. (cont.) 1. As indicated in referenced telecon, #10, Cartridge IV of Subject report was retained by graphics because it shows an Extourist guide in Minsk, USSR. One of the unidentified men in this picture bears a strong resemblance to Lee Harvey Oswald. SR/CI came across this picture and requested permission to forward it, together with 00-B-3212967 (1A-28641) and the sources' identities to the FBI and the Warren Commission. After checking with you, we gave CI staff permission to do so. The understanding is that the FBI will go back to the sources for further info. on this subject.

2. CI now has two questions which we cannot answer from records available here: 1) Date & place where photo was made available to contact specialist; 2) CI is making statement that these 2 women weren't contacted before or during this trip. Believe this to be true statement but would appreciate confirmation. Also, advise as to date(s) & # of contacts of Miss Voellmy w/ these women.

1. Unable to reach Voellmy, now attached to Denver office. Records show that she probably saw ladies in Solvang only once (after their return from USSR). Suggest you call her for details. "But we are sure Tina did not see the ladies before the trip and certainly not (by us) during the trip."

12(cont.) 2. File cards indicate that Kramer & Naman were both debriefed on 3/7/62. Both were noted to be "very cooperative".

On 3/9/62 we sent LA Report 28615 (Passport on loan), 28615 (8mm movie on loan) & 28618 (brochures for retention).

On 3/13/62 Report 28641 (OO-B on Realities).

3/22/62 ^{letter} Mina to Kramer - Returning passport & awaiting slides.

3/27/62 - Return of film by Mina to Naman by mail.

4/30/62 - LA Report 29005 (4 cartridges of 40 35mm slides).

3. HQS routing slip indicates GMP staff returned slides directly to Kramer on 5/17/62 w/interesting comment, "Most of the slides are of the usual tourist variety and hence are of little value." Of the 160 slides 5 were "accessioned".
