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Eusebio Azguez Lopez, ex Cuban Consul in Mexico was born circa 1911 in Havana Cuba. His passport number was D/59/459.

Circa 1952 Azguez was living in France and was arrested by French authorities on charges resulting from his involvement in smuggling gemstones and other antiques into France. He was in jail for 16 months.

In a January 3, 1963 report, headquarters reported extreme interest in mounting an operation aimed at the recruitment of Azguez. The report states that Azguez was an architect, intelligent, who felt for Cubans but unfortunately has communist tendencies. Most of the file deals with the efforts of Carlos Rodriguez to recruit Azguez <sup>for the</sup> CIA. Amongst those reporting on Azguez for CIA and attempting to recruit him were: Istanbul 3, Istanbul -7, Istanbul -9, and Ankara -1.

Lawrence P. Barker met E Istanbul -9 <sup>Nov. 4, 1963</sup> who stated that he saw Azguez talking with Sylvia Duran recently in the office -- checking her for being a Communist. Sylvia replied, "It's not true. I am not a Stalinist and I have never been interested in Party membership." L-9 thinks Sylvia is a very intelligent girl. He thinks we may be able to gain her cooperation by getting a desirable male next to her -- she is, according to L-9, "a little putter." (this memo is not complete.)

Azguez left for Cuba Nov 18, 1963.

Agave was called in about Sept. 16 by Osmann  
Carbajero and almost first time his got Cuba Security was  
also entered of Agave. Agave who had been given the  
responsibility of the Problem at the Ego 67 in Medell had  
apparently failed miserably in fulfilling his job. Carbajero who  
considered the Ego 67 affair a very very important asset told  
Agave he had "abandoned" the project and since nothing  
Agave was at the point of leaving first when he produced  
a letter he had written to a front organization which asked  
for assistance and to not let him perform. This  
letter apparently "saved" Agave from being summarily  
fired from his post but it did not stop Carbajero from relieving  
Agave of his responsibilities re Ego 67. This man in work  
Carbajero has made Agave a very bitter man; he wants  
to get out of Cuba as soon as possible. → His plans are to  
leave Cuba for Mexico almost the end of the year (in pencil)  
Agave plans to see a last withdrawal as "cover" to get  
to Mexico.
