[GENE COX]

[REDACTED] stated that she had been in Mexico from 1955 - 1960 and from 1965 - 1968. She said she was in [REDACTED] in 1963.

She stated that she was replaced by [REDACTED] in 1960.

[TED WALSH]

She said that [REDACTED] had originally gone to Mexico as a CI staffer but had ended up working personally for [REDACTED] on operations such as the [REDACTED] step.
