Paragraph 2. "Vladimir Rodriguez Aakera DPOB 6 February 1937, Havana, Cuba, was a former DGT staff officer who defected on 21 April 1964 in Halifax Nova Scotia. He was debriefed and handled through normal defector channels and was the source of numerous ESCI's concerning the DGT in 1964 and 65. He was used operationally in recruitment attempts against DGT officers during 1964-1967. He was terminated in July 1967, and was considered, but never used, for another recruitment attempt in 1971. <sup>Since 1971,</sup> Rodriguez has not been involved in any CIA operation in Miami or elsewhere. Joseph Norris is the alias of a CIA representative who periodically debriefs Rodriguez on personalities and methods of the DGT. There is no other CIA involvement with Rodriguez.

Handwritten Declaration re status of SLANK/1 states in part:

"Informed 'Calvin' on 15 April 77 that SLANK/1 is still an active contact, not receiving any salary, but could be paid if and when used in an operation. No problems here. SPOB will keep his contract in an active folder." R.H. 15 April 77

SUBJECT: American Defectors

Refers to SRS memo on Am. defectors dated 31 Oct. 60.

"Mrs. Ann Egster, of the CI Staff, has furnished me the attached copy of a letter from Mr. Hugh S. Cummings, Jr., of the State Dept., to Mr. Richard M. Bissell of this Agency, dated 25 Oct. 60. w/ reference to "Am. defectors" from May 1959 to Oct. 1960. Mr. Cummings asked if this Agency "could verify and possibly expand" a list which accompanied his letter; and Mrs. Egster is preparing a reply to him."

Cummings list includes 12 names, 8 of which are referred to in SRS memo on Am. defectors of 13 Oct. 1960.

Security records on other 4 reflect following:

1. Sgt. Ernie F. Feltcher: According to N.Y.T. article of 7/14/59, Feltcher was believed, by U.S. Army authorities, to have defected to Communist East Germany; also that Soviet Army HQs in E. Berlin stated on 29 June 59 that Feltcher had asked for political asylum in E. Germany. No further info.
2. David Dubois: As of 21 Sept. 59, he was in London preparing to go to Peking via Moscow for a 3 yr. stay. He is step son of W.E.B. DuBois. Nothing in files indicates that he is considered a defector.
3. Morris & Mollie Block: U.S. delegate to Moscow Youth Festival in 1957; subsequently traveled to China at invitation of Chinese Peoples Republic. References indicate he is extreme leftist & pro-Communist but not a defector. MS file cannot be located at this time.

McLann was issued a U.S. passport in 4 Feb. 59 & it is assumed he traveled to Communist China @ Feb. 59 when his mother & step-father, W.E.B. DuBois travelled there. McLann was attending Peking University in Dec. 59 with intentions to study there for about 3 years.

23 Oct. 61 Memo, DDP to Dir., FBI : States that McLann left China & is now teaching at the Cairo University under name of David DuBois.

File review indicates that DuBois was employed in Cairo for several years as a journalist and by 3/63 he had acquired Ghanaian citizenship. Last reports (1967) indicate he is still in Cairo.
