The following is a brief summary of the subversive activity of the subject and it is believed that it qualifies subject for Category III of the ADEX.

On 1/2/72, NY 7495-PSI advised that subject was one of the founders of the Vencerenios Brigade (VB); on 2/8/71, and 2/9/71, NY 6474-Stadvised that the subject was then helping to organize and recruit for the 3rd contingent of the VB; on 9/18/71, NY 6474-Stadvised that the subject was beginning to organize the 4th contingent of the VB, and that it would probably leave for Cuba in December, 1971 or January, 1972. On 9/21/71, NY 6474-Stadvised that the subject attended a demonstration and march to protest against prison revolt at Attica, held on 9/18/71, in NYC, NY; on 7/20/71, 10/15/71, and 11/8/71, subject was observed by SAs of the FBI to enter and/or leave the Cuban Mission in NY, NY
