162 222* If Subject's Identification Record is desired it is suggested a check be made under his true name and Sedgwick County, Kansas, Sheriff's Office number 14663.

Attorney CLYDE WENDELKEN advised confidentially on 4/28/59 that Subject's father, JACK HALL, told him that an individual he knew only as JET, who had telephone number Hobart 4-7074, had possibly had information concerning the Subject which would be of interest. WENDELKEN stated that he felt that Mr. HALL was undoubtedly afraid to give this number to the FBI, however, he would give it to the Bureau on a confidential basis and did not want his name disclosed in the matter.

It was determined that this telephone number is unlisted and is subscribed to by CHARLES D. TRAVER of 1040 Lewellen. Considerable efforts to locate TRAVER on 4/28/59 met with negative results. He will be located as soon as possible and a supplemental report will be forwarded to the Bureau. This lead will be given expeditious attention.
