MM T-2 advised that BOSCH told him that he suspected CIA of planting the microphone. Neither BOSCH nor GARCIA offered any proof. These allegations were not

It is to be noted that BOSCH is fully capable of falsely claiming that such a microphone had been planted on him.

Miami will continue to investigate the activities of the MIRR and will keep the Bureau advised of all pertinent developments.
