CHIBAS told DE GASTER that this meeting would probably be the last meeting where all of them would be together.

NY T-1, who is in contact with members of the Junta Revolucionaria Cubana (JURE) in New York and San Juan, Puerto Rico, on May 6, 1964, stated M. Y that he had spoken with Dr. Raul/Chibas, who is a member of the National Directorate of JURE. NY T-1 advised that Dr. Chibas told him on May 5, 1964, that the members of the National Directorate of JURE held their last meeting in Miami, Florida, on the weekend of May 2-3, 1964. Chibas stated that Manuel "Manolo May, the head of JURE, is determined to fulfill his promise of being inside Cuba by May 20, 1964. Chibas stated that he was not going to accompany the group of JURE going to Cuba in May, 1964, as he still had to fulfill his teaching contract in New York until the end of June, 1964.

NY T-1 also advised on May 6, 1964, that he spoke with <u>Angel Figueredo</u>, who is the delegate of the JURE in <u>New York</u>, who informed him that the action contemplated by JURE will not be anything spectacular but will be an infiltration move into Cuba, and Manolo Ray will accompany this infiltration group.

NY T-1 also advised on May 6, 1964, that he had spoken with Carlos Diago, a member of the JURE in San Juan, Puerto Rico, who informed him that some of the men of Major Hubert. Matos had joined forces with JURE and would be accompanying the group into Cuba sometime before May 20, 1964. NY T-1 also advised that he had ascertained from Diago that the members of the <u>Ejercito</u> <u>de Liberacion Nacional (ELN)</u> which is headed by Nino Diaz, would also join with JURE.

Concerning Major Hubert Matos mentioned above, it is to be noted that he is one of the leading figures of the Cuban Revolution who was arrested by the Cuban Government in late 1959 and currently is serving a 30 year prison sentence on the Isle of Pines. The followers of Hubert Matos have formed an organization which is known as Ejercito Libertador de Cuba (ELC).

NY T-2, on May 11, 1964, advised that he had been to Miami, Florida, on the weekend of May 2-3, 1964, and met with Manolo Ray on the evening of May 3, 1964, at the Dupont Plaza Hotel, at 8:00 p.m. The purpose of the meeting with Ray was to work out an arrangement whereby NY T-2 would accompany Ray on his infiltration move into Cuba which is scheduled to take place on or before May 20, 1964.

NY T-2 advised that from Ray he learned that the last meeting of the National Directorate of JURE was held in Miami on May 2-3, 1964, and the members of the National Directorate who attended this meeting. included the following: Manuel Ray of San Juan, Fuerto Rico;
