Underwood then proposed that payment be deferred until after delivery of the arms in Cuban ALL INFORMATION CONTAINED waters, and BAYQ accepted this offer. He, Underwood, and Alberto BAYO Cosgaya, BAYO Giroud's son, then left New York by ship for Haiti.
