(u) Miami informants, MM 639-S, MM 1337-S, MM 635-S, MM 974-S, MM 847-S, and MM 1248-S, all of whom are well informed concerning some Cuban revolutionary activities, possessed no information concerning this matter.

On November 5, 1969, Mr. LUIS RODRIGUEZ, Investigator, 111th INTC Group (Military Intelligence), Miami, advised that ADOLFO JIMENEZ AGUILERA is only a casual source and is not on the payroll of his agency. He said that JIMENEZ has contacted him four or five times in the past several years and that he was in contact with JIMENEZ twice in 1967 (u)
